The Jet Trek is staged by Variety Queensland to raise funds to assist bringing about an improved quality of life for children with special needs throughout Queensland.

By visiting a number of different schools along the way, not only do Jet Trekkers get to participate in an action packed, awe inspiring event, they also experience first hand the help they are bringing to local communities and families, and a sense of where their FUNdraising efforts are going.

Since 1998, Trekkers have raised over a quarter of a million dollars for Variety Queensland, with the 2010 event culminating in a record breaking \$175,000. Funds raised by these adrenalin junkies are utilised to purchase mobility and educational equipment for individual children and facilities, Sunshine Coaches, and Liberty Swings for communities.

SAFETY TO THE EXTREME!

As with all Variety Queensland events, safety is paramount. Travelling with you on the Trek will be an experienced team, including medical support, mechanics, PWC experts and on water recovery crews.

PERSONAL WATER CRAFT

The eligibility criteria for Personal Water Crafts in the Jet Trek event are as follows:

- Must be a sit down craft, not stand up
- Must be newer than 2004

THE COST?

You will need to raise a minimum of \$2000 which is tax deductible. A \$55 application fee is required with the application form and a provision levy that includes meals, event merchandise and DVD will be set closer to the event date.
